#### BY CAR OR COACH

Within reach of the IAA, all highway exits (e.g. A5, Frankfurt West/Messe) and streets leading towards the IAA visitor parking lots are signposted by the IAA guidance system. This traffic guidance signage by the police responds dynamically to road capacities.

Therefore following personal/individual GPS devices to reach the trade fair grounds is not advisable within the metropolitan area. It is instead recommended to follow the IAA signage and the IAA service personnel along the way.

The IAA visitor parking lots are located outside Frankfurt's Environmental Emission Zone and can be used without an official emission zone permit (exception: lot "Gleisdreieck").

#### CHARGING ELECTRIC VEHICLES

For IAA visitors who travel with electric cars, charging points will be available in the Rebstock parking garage close to the exhibition grounds. Apart from the regular parking fee, the charging is free. All charging points use Type 2 connectors. As charging places are limited, please register with Messe Frankfurt in due time at emobil@messefrankfurt.com.

### BY TRAIN

Take the train to Frankfurt/Main "Hauptbahnhof" (central station) and continue from there by foot (15 min.), by taxi, or public transport.

Please note that the IAA entry ticket is not included in the Deutsche Bahn event ticket. The VDA and DB wish you a pleasant journey!

### BY PUBLIC TRANSPORT FROM CENTRAL STATION

Take the tram lines 16 or 17, or the S-Bahn (suburban rail) lines S3, S4, S5, or S6 to "Messe". Or take the subway U4 to "Festhalle/Messe". IAA tickets are not valid for public transport.

#### BY INTERCITY BUS SERVICE

Intercity buses from various providers arrive directly in the center of Frankfurt/Main at the central train station ("Hauptbahnhof"). From there, you can get to the IAA trade fair grounds ("Messegelände") by foot (approximately 15 min.), by taxi, or by public transport (see above).

#### BY AIRPLANE

From Frankfurt Airport (FRA) either take a taxi (20 min.) to the exhibition grounds or use public transport - the S-Bahn (suburban rail) - to "Hauptbahnhof" (central station). From there you can walk (15 min.), take a taxi, or use public transport (see above).

### BARRIER-FREE ACCESS TO THE SHOW
